The March for Life

Katherine Thompson, a Confirmation youth, here at St.
Mary's recently attend the March for Life in Washing-
ton D.C. When questioned about the trip, she stated:



*"I realized **The March for Life** event in Washington
D.C. is not just about being Pro-Life and preventing abortion, it's
also about protecting everyone through all stages of life, including
natural death. I realized this when my mom and I attended the Prayer
Rally. I thought, and probably most people think that a Prayer Rally
is just singing hymns and praying. It's not. The Rally was a concert
where many dioceses across the country came together the night
before the march, not only to pray, but to celebrate and have a good
time while listening to a pop Christian singer, Matt Maher, and few
guest speakers. It was then, while I was looking over the massive
crowd, that I realized that this was more than just being
"Pro-Life" and touring the Monuments. Before the March began, we
had Mass at the Basilica with Bishop Cunningham, where everyone
came together again, then we went to Constitution Ave for the
March. In a crowd of thousands my mom and I were among over 400
marchers from the Diocese of Syracuse. My mom and I were the only
ones from the Northern Region of the diocese and we hope to fill a
whole bus of marchers from Oswego/Fulton next year."*
