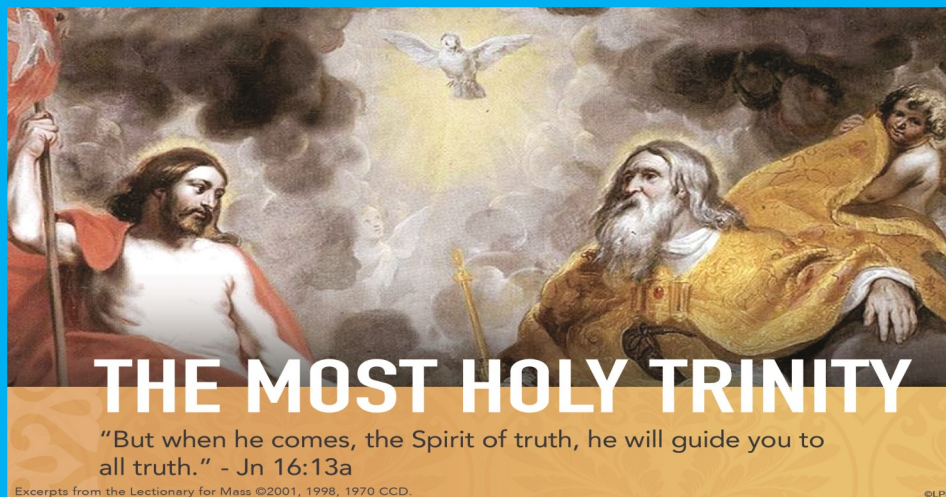

Father John Canorro, has been named pastor of Christ the Good Shepherd! Fr. Canorro, is presently serving as pastor at St. Rose of Lima in Syracuse. He is a native of East Syracuse and St. Matthew's Church. His assignments include: parochial vicar of Holy Cross Church in Dewitt and faculty member at Bishop Grimes Jr./Sr. High School, Holy Trinity Church in Fulton, Christ Our Light in Pulaski and St. Anne, Mother of Mary in Mexico. Fr. Canorro is an avid golfer and is known as 'Father Cookie', for his great baking skills, which he learned from his mother. He is also an EMT/firefighter. Welcome Fr. Canorro!



Pope Francis appointed Bishop-elect Douglas Lucia, of the Ogdensburg Diocese, as the 11th Bishop of the Diocese of Syracuse. Father Douglas Lucia, 56, was born on March 17, 1963 in Plattsburgh, New York. He attended Wadhams Hall Seminary College, followed by Christ the King Seminary in East Aurora, New York. He then attended the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas in Rome, Italy. He was ordained to the priesthood on May 20, 1989 for the Diocese of Ogdensburg. Father



Lucia's assignments after ordination include: parochial vicar of St. Patrick's Church in Watertown; parochial vicar of St. Mary's Cathedral in Ogdensburg; administrator, St. Mary in Canton; associate secretary to the tribunal and chaplain at Gouverneur Correctional Facility; secretary to the bishop, vocation director, director of seminarians; pastor of St. John in Morristown; St. Peter, Hammond; and St. Patrick in Rossie. He has also served as episcopal vicar for worship and priestly formation. Father Lucia was most recently pastor of St. Mary's Church in Waddington and St. John the Baptist in Madrid, NY as well as judicial vicar for the diocese.

**Holy Spirit, help us renew the face of the Earth**

A grim milestone— atmospheric carbon dioxide levels have reached their highest level in more than 3 million years. Sensors at the Mauna Loa Observatory in Hawaii recorded that concentrations of CO2 reached 415 parts per million in late May. In the 800,000 years before the Industrial Revolution, CO2 levels never surpassed 300ppm. The last time CO2 was this high was during the Pliocene Epoch, between 5.3 million and 2.6 million years ago, when sea levels were about 50 feet higher than they are now. Gavin Schmidt of NASA says, "...we are putting our foot on the accelerator of climate change..."

June 18 is the 4th anniversary of **Laudato Si'** where Pope Francis urged us to work with the Spirit to renew the face of the Earth. **On Care for Our Common Home (Laudato Si')** is the appeal from Pope Francis addressed to "every person living on this planet" for an inclusive dialogue about how we are shaping the future of our planet. Pope Francis calls the Church and the world to acknowledge the urgency of our environmental challenges and to join him in embarking on a new path.
