Northern Region 2014 Seeds of Faith Award Winner!!

Nominees for this prestigious award, named after Sr. Katie Eiffe, csj, must be a certified level one Catechist who displays creative teaching and interaction with the youth as well as foster catechetical support for the families of the program. The award winner must also be active in developing their own faith journey through continued faith formation certifications.

When asked what she gets out teaching the youth? She replied:

"I get the joy of watching the children begin to understand what having faith in God means, what their faith in God can do for them and to them. I love teaching them about prayer, using skits to teach them the Gospels, talking about their issues and how to take care of things and still maintain their Christian beliefs. I like to help them discover how they feel about some social justice issues. And I have fun doing it. Sometimes it is difficult time wise but in the end it is worth it."

Maureen, what does being a Catechist require of you? *"It could only require that I look over the material and see how I want to present it but I require more of myself. I like looking for more things that go with the lessons to make them more meaningful and interesting. It basically requires that I have fun with the kids while I am teaching them something."*

Catechesis is said to mean "echo". Helping others to know, love & share in God's love is truly an echo worth hearing and repeating at any age!!
