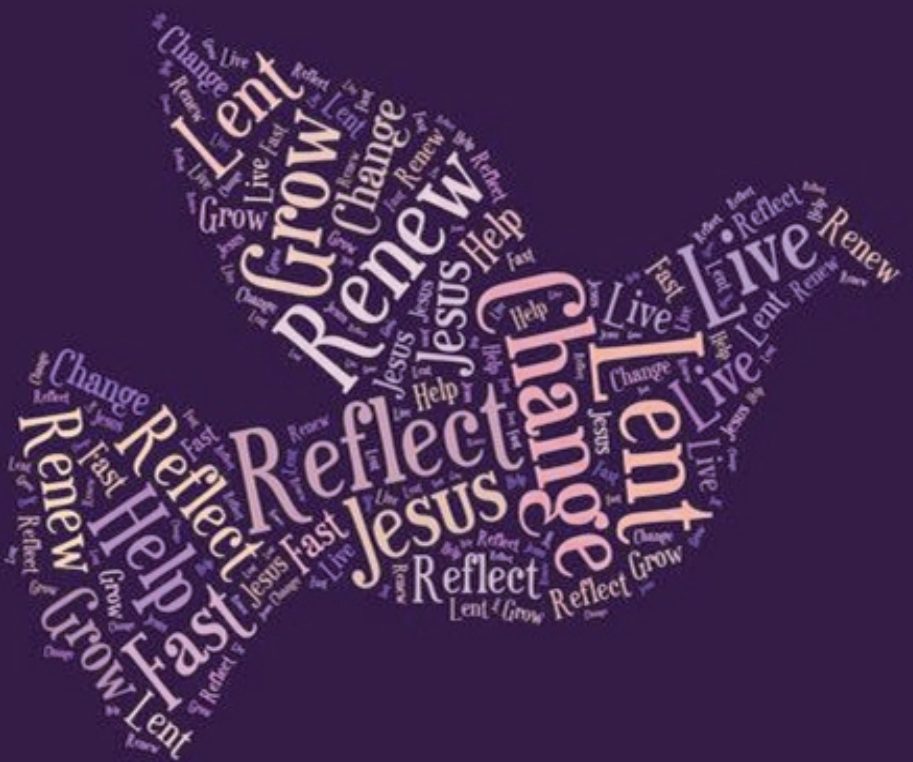

Second Collection April 6/7: Catholic Education

**Drought in Central America:** In the U.S. we have not heard about the climate change induced drought affecting large sections of Central America. In this parched region Catholic Relief Services (CRS) works with people like Maria to stem hunger and develop alternative food and job alternatives. Meager rainfall in the southern Guatemala, El Salvador and Honduras makes it hard for families like Maria's to grow enough corn and beans to last the year. Most families, including Maria's have not produced a full harvest since the drought hit four years ago.

Maria worked 14 hour days picking coffee that made her too weak to carry her child. The paltry \$110 she earned per month hardly made up for the anxiety she felt over leaving her other children at home alone.

At a November 2017 CRS sponsored fair Maria and her husband bought a dozen chickens, agricultural tools including a watering can, and seeds to grow cilantro and radishes in their garden. Their life has improved measurable. Please give generously to Catholic Relief Services this weekend.
