Facilities Improvements at Our Lady of the Rosary Volunteers Needed!

We are continuing with facility improvements associated with sale of the Rectory. A new handicapped ramp has been installed at the North end of the hall, gas and water lines have been re-routed and a new parking lot has been installed behind the church. Volunteers will be needed to help rake and seed areas that have been excavated, painting of a new shed that will be installed at the north end of the hall and installation of a concrete slab at the bottom of the handicapped ramp. Sale of the Rectory is now essentially complete. Please avoid using south driveway when entering the Hall. The North entry to the hall should now be the primary entryway to the Hall.
